MINUTES

Gordo called the meeting to order at 6:08 p.m.

It was decided that Claire would go to the BEC and take pictures of all of the sign in sheets to date and get the copies to Mark so that he has a way to disperse the funds. Jo will also send out an email to everyone that works, to let them know that they need to make sure that the last person signed in on the sheets on that shift, takes a picture of the sign in sheet and gets it to Mark.

The board then discussed other fundraisers that might be starting in the spring such as Qdoba coupons and selling pies instead of butter braids. Mark Clay said that he would head the Qdoba sales and Mark Gibson will talk to Mark Clay and see if he still wants to do that. Terese will look into how the basketball team sold pies and get the information to Kelly Kenyon who would be in charge of the sales.

Gordo will email the sign-up sheets for help needed with Shrek to Jo and she will get them out on the volunteer site and Facebook to get the word out that help is needed.

Phil told the board that kids are putting together lists for concession items that will be needed for the show. They are then going to go to businesses and ask for donations. Clark will be a back-up to get whatever else is needed that they cannot get.

Terese let the board know that since her child is graduating this year, she will not be on the board next year, 2014/2015, so the board will need to start looking for another parent to fill the publicist position.

New Business:

Jo thinks that it would be a good idea to have the booster club meeting going out on mass email so that more people will know about it and get involved. The board thought that this was a good idea and Jo will get that started.

The dragon costume is amazing and will be here soon.

Jo will send out a mass email for volunteers to help with backstage, concessions, etc.

Choir update: 6 kids made it into the Allstate Choir competition this year. Allstate competition will be in Denver Feb. 6-8th. There will be a bus on Saturday the 8th for all choir kids that would like to see the competition and the cost for that will be \$5.00 per person.

Phil held auditions this year for kids to get into choirs. They had to sing part of a song, do some sight reading etc. to see which choirs they will make it into next year. He is also going to go to Conball and have incoming 8th graders audition for choirs so that they feel part of Mountain View.

L.A. Trip-Pete let the board know that we have sent in the first check to the travel agency in early December. They will be having the kids pick room partners, four to a room starting in a few weeks. They will be handing out papers to let kids know what is still due regarding monies and forms.

The board discussed this and decided that yes it would be possible to do this. Someone would just have to designate where they wanted it to go.
