September 14, 2009

Minutes from last meeting were approved.

Treasurer's Report:

Thompson School District Acct.: \$7,626.51

MVMA Thompson ID Acct.: \$148.86

MVMA Acct.: \$14,375.83

Greg Schairer reported that our income included Boston trip deposits of \$7,100 and fundraiser product sales of \$6,000 (cookie dough/flower bulbs and King Soopers cards). Treasurer's report was approved.

Band:

Jennifer Hanna requested parent volunteers to provide snacks for marching band for after football games/band events. Sign-up sheet was passed around.

John Kampf reported that we have approval from Rick Logan (Athletic Director) to sell any of our previously-approved fundraiser items at home football games.

Upcoming marching band events include Homecoming football game Sept. 25 and CU Band Day Sept. 26.

Jazz Band concert on Sept. 29 will feature Darren Kramer, trombonist, who will conduct clinics with students during that day and perform at the concert that night. We are selling tickets for \$5 to help offset our cost of \$1,500.

Choir:

Parent help is needed for uniform fittings for choirs. Uniforms/shoes are on order.

Orchestra:

Theatre:

Melissa Champion reported that 85 students auditioned for this year's shows. All costumes for "Children of Eden" will be rented (from NY). Home Depot has offered \$3,000 for supplies for the shows. #### Boston Trip:

Adults going on the trip all need to pay \$100 deposit, even if they may be chosen as chaperones.

Currently, 77 students (music and theatre) and 33 adults are planning to go on the trip. Cost is fluctuating based on several variables.

DATES HAVE BEEN CHANGED TO May 26-30 (Wed.-Sun.)! With our original itinerary, Sat. would only have been travel. Boston Red Sox game may not be available with new trip dates, but an alternate activity would be substituted.

Airline may be United or Southwest.

Payments of \$300 will be due Oct. 30, mid-Dec., Jan., with remaining balance due early April. Deposits and trip payments are non-refundable. All payments should be made to “MVMA.”

If using funds from a student account, you must turn in a note stating your request. Funds will not be automatically deducted for trip payments.
